



TRAVIS WONG

Inducted into the "Inside Kung Fu: Hall of Fame" at the age of 14, Travis Wong has been featured in over 30+ international ad campaigns, stunt coordinated videos for artists such as Jennifer Lopez, Camila Cabello, Chris Brown, Miley Cyrus, Jason Derulo, and performed on stages from Universal Studios to the red carpet in Cannes.

Travis recently completed Stunt Coordinating A24's upcoming "Onslaught," HBO & DC Comic's "Lanterns," and "Mike, Nick, Nick & Alice" which are set to release in 2026. He also coordinated Netflix's "Back in Action" which is nominated for 3 Taurus World Stunt Awards, the recent horror remake "Witchboard," as well as "HIM" produced by Jordan Peele. He was the Fight Coordinator of the ABC's series STUMPTOWN as well as the final 2 seasons of MARVEL's LEGION. He also stunt coordinated motion capture for Minions 2: The Rise of Gru, Jet Li's film *League Of Gods*, additional photography for Snake Eyes, *Pacific Rim: Uprising*, and choreographed/shot previs for *The First Purge*, *Doctor Strange*, *The Happytime Murders*, *Future Man*.

He performed parkour motion capture for the lead character of Mowgli in Disney's "The Jungle Book," and was the Assistant Fight Coordinator of Universals "Furious 7" which he received a nomination from the Screen Actors Guild Awards. Both films held the record for being the two largest openings in April box office history, grossing a combined 2+ billion dollars to date internationally.



While obtaining a B.A. in Theater & Dance from the University of California, Santa Barbara (UCSB), Travis was introduced to the sport of parkour & freerunning. One of only 30 internationally sponsored athletes of the World Freerunning and Parkour Federation (WFPPF), Travis has risen as an instrumental figure within this growing community. He was the host of MTV's Ultimate Parkour Challenge as well as the first MC for the Red Bull Art of Motion Parkour Championships.

Travis is a Parkour and Tricking Consultant for the world renown Cirque du Soleil, and helped in the creation of the traveling show VOLTA. He continues his role as a parkour guest speaker for the Navy Seal Foundation, traveling to bases around the world. Travis has the opportunity to share his experiences in the entertainment industry as well as stressing the importance of focus when approaching parkour and life. In helping individuals change their daily mindset and the way they approach the world.

In addition to parkour, Travis is also recognized as a leader in the martial arts tricking community. The first credited Tricker in motion picture history for his role in Step Up 3D, he has also been instrumental in its organization as a formally recognized sport. Travis created the first online battle series "TRICKSTAR: The Search for the Ultimate Tricker," and was the Red Bull TV host of the "Kick It" and "Art of Motion" championships.

In 2012, Travis opened the world renown movement facility Joining All Movement (JAM) in Los Angeles, providing a home to stunt practitioners, parkour and tricking athletes, and movement fanatics from around the world. It is currently the home to Red Bull world champions and the creative ground for some of Hollywood's biggest films. In 2022 a second location was opened in Atlanta, GA, providing a secondary home for previs action design, rehearsals, and training for the entertainment industry on the east coast.
